

Madeirans: The First Indentured Labourers in Suriname (1863-1864)¹

Madeirenses: Os Primeiros Trabalhadores Contratados no Suriname (1863-1864)

Summary

Madeiran Portuguese were the first indentured labourers to arrive in Suriname, a former colony of the Netherlands that gained its independence in 1975. It is located in Latin America, North of Brazil, West of French Guiana, East of Guyana and has a coast on the Atlantic Ocean in the North. The first enslaved Africans were transported to Suriname to work on the plantations around the year 1650. Slavery was abolished in 1863, more than 200 hundred years later, due to a reduction in sugar production and a decrease in the slave population caused by the extremely high mortality rate.

Indentured labourers were transported to Suriname to work on the plantations before the abolition of slavery. The first indentured labourers came from Madeira. Madeirans who were not indentured labourers also travelled to Suriname. This concerns a total of

500 Portuguese Madeirans (indentured labourers and free Portuguese). The first group of indentured labourers arrived in 1853. The last groups arrived in Suriname between 21 December 1863 and 11 November 1864. A total of 218 Portuguese indentured labourers.

Resumo

Portugueses madeirenses foram os primeiros trabalhadores contratados a chegar ao Suriname, uma ex-colónia da Holanda que conquistou a sua independência em 1975. Está localizada na América Latina, Norte do Brasil, Oeste da Guiana Francesa, Leste da Guiana e tem costa no Oceano Atlântico no Norte. Os primeiros escravos africanos foram transportados para o Suriname para trabalhar nas plantações por volta do ano de 1650. A escravatura foi abolida em 1863, mais de 200 séculos depois, devido à redução da produção de açúcar e à diminuição da população escrava causada pela extremamente alta taxa de mortalidade.

Trabalhadores contratados foram transportados para o Suriname para trabalhar nas plantações antes da abolição da escravatura. Os primeiros trabalhadores contratados vieram da Madeira. Madeirenses que não eram trabalhadores contratados também viajaram para o Suriname. Trata-se de um total de 500 portugueses madeirenses (trabalhadores contratados e portugueses livres). O primeiro grupo de trabalhadores contratados chegou em 1853. Os últimos grupos chegaram ao Suriname entre 21 de dezembro de 1863 e 11 de novembro de 1864. Um total de 218 trabalhadores contratados portugueses.

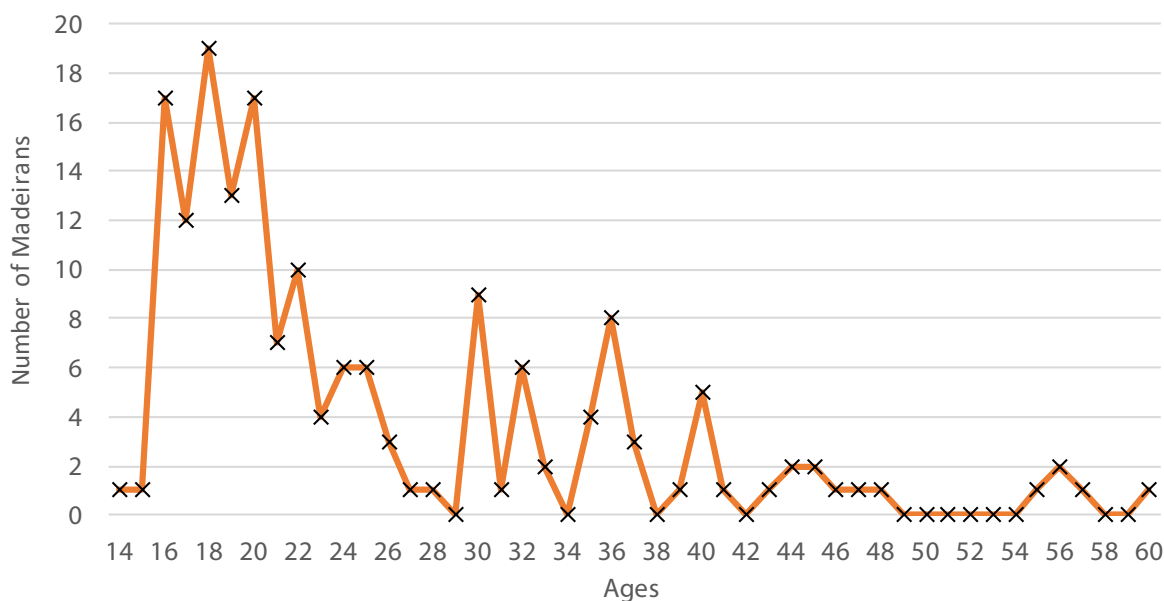

Age Distribution of The Indentured Labourers

The first indentured labourers put to work in Suriname came from Madeira. Besides indentured labourers, Madeirans who were not indentured labourers also travelled to Suriname. A total of 500 Portuguese from Madeira – indentured labourers and Madeirans travelling independently – travelled to Suriname. The first group of indentured labourers arrived in the year 1853. The last groups arrived in Suriname between 21 December 1863 and 11 November 1864. This amounted to a total of 218 Portuguese indentured labourers. The article concerns this group of 218 Portuguese indentured labourers. It consisted of 61 women, 13 of whom were younger than 11 years of age, and 157 men, 14 of whom were under 11 years of age. The age of 11 members of the group of 218 indentured labourers is not stated in the archive material. Further, I did not include 36 children (0 – 13 years old) in the following age distribution graph because their youth precluded the signing of a labour contract

with a planter. The remaining 171 indentured labourers (218 minus 11 and 36) were then categorised by age, as presented below.

High Mortality Rate

A particularly notable aspect of the Madeiran indentured labourers in Suriname is their high mortality rate. 87 of the 218 indentured labourers died within the contract period, which equates to 39,9% of the group. The percentage is higher than amongst the West Indian indentured labourers who were transported to Suriname between 1863 and 1899³. The Portuguese indentured labourers migrated in a relatively short period, namely between 21 December 1863 and 21 November 1864. This is why it was impossible to ascertain how the mortality rate would have developed if the migration had occurred over a longer period. The majority of deaths occurred amongst young people, from 20 to 25 years of age. This is not unusual because most of the indentured labourers were in that age category.

Another aspect of the high mortality rate amongst the Madeirans that occurred occasionally is the successive deaths of different members of a family within a short period. This applied to several families, including the family of Da Silva / Manoël⁴. He arrived in Suriname on the Portuguese schooner *Mathilda* on 15 August 1864. He was 35 years old and was accompanied by his wife, the 25-year-old Jezus/Maria, and their daughters Jezus / Maria (6 years old) and Jezus Maria (14 months old). Both parents were put to work at the De Drie Gebroeders plantation, owned by B.C. van der Ende. The father died on 6 September 1864, less than a month after arriving in Suriname. The 14-month-old daughter died several months later on 8 May 1865, followed by her older sister, who died on 29 December 1865. The mother died less than six months later on 29 May 1866. Another example that is almost identical concerns the family of Coelho / Antonio. He arrived in Suriname on the Portuguese schooner *Mathilda* on 15 August 1864, aged 32 and was accompanied by his 30-year-old wife Gonsalvos / Viçinça, and their three children: Gonsalvos / Antonio (9 years old), Gonsalvos / Maria (7) and Gonsalvos / Louisa (6). The parents were employed by B.C. van den Ende, owner of the De Drie Gebroeders plantation. The father died on 7 October 1865. The oldest child died two months later on 20 December 1865. The second child died less than one month later on 8 January 1866, and the wife of Coelho / Antonio and mother of the three children died on 14 February 1866. It is stated in the archive material that the third child, who was still alive at that time, was «dismissed»⁵. A strange designation.

The death of three young children in one family is a more dramatic case. The 35-year-old José / Manöel, his wife Jezus Maria Theresia of the same age and their four young children aged 6, 4, 2 and one month old arrived on the Portuguese schooner *Mathilda* on 15 August 1864. The man and wife were put to work on the De Drie Gebroeders plantation. Three of their four children died within three months of their arrival. The first to die was Jezus / Julia, the 2-year-old daughter, on 9 November 1864, with the oldest child, the son Jezus / Januario, dying one week later on 16 November 1864. The youngest son, Jezus / José, who had been born less than one month earlier, died less than two weeks later on 1 December 1864. The parents were left with their 4-year-old son, Jezus / Manoël. All three left the plantation when their contracts expired. It is striking that all three terrible cases of death of various members of a family involved indentured labourers who worked on the De Drie

Gebroeders plantation. That was one of the two plantations where the majority of deaths occurred.

It could be expected that the indentured labourers would have opposed the labour system, due to the extremely high mortality rate and the occasionally deeply tragic circumstances in which they occurred. However, there is no evidence of this happening. There is almost no information that indicates resistance. Only two Madeirans absconded, namely the 18-year-old Fernandes de Viloza / José and the 16-year-old Camacho / Feliciano. Fernandes de Viloza / José arrived in Suriname on the Portuguese schooner *Trez Amigos* on 11 November 1864. Eight days later, on 19 November 1864, he signed a contract with J. R. Arias in Paramaribo, the capital city of Suriname, to work as a servant in his house. This commitment was to expire on 18 November 1867. Apparently, Fernandes de Viloza / José broke the labour contract before that date. The second case of abscondment concerns the 16-year-old Camacho / Feliciano. He arrived in Paramaribo on the same ship and on the same date. We have no further information on either of these indentured labourers.

Descendants of Madeirans

After their contracts expired a great many Madeirans left the plantations and settled in Paramaribo, the capital city of Suriname. Some of them returned to Madeira. It is clear that some indentured labourers remained resident in Suriname and began working as traders after the expiry of their contract. «In 1879 there were approximately 25 retail stores in Paramaribo, and by 1898 the number had increased to around 50. In that year, the Madeirans ran 10 to 15% of the provisions stores»⁶. Both authors also note the following: «They did not become an important trading group, and competition with the Chinese and Lebanese meant that by around 1940 there were no more than approximately 10 Portuguese trading companies in Paramaribo that belonged to those who had arrived in this century.»⁷ Dos Ramos⁸ specifies the following well-known stores: Madeira Bazaar owned by Carlos Thomas, Bettencourt owned by the Gonsalves family and Vasconcellos owned by the family of the same name. In Guyana, the English-speaking country neighbouring Suriname, a significant number of Madeirans also opted to start a trading business when

their contract period expired. And here is where the similarity between Madeirans in Suriname and Guyana ends. This is because the proportion of Madeirans in the trading business was far greater in Guyana than in Suriname. According to Rollo Younge⁹, 173 of the total of 296 stores in Georgetown (equivalent to 58%) were owned by Madeirans in 1853, 20 years after the arrival of the first indentured labourers in Guyana. In the villages the percentage was higher, namely 283 of the 432 stores, which equates to 65%. «By 1851 in Georgetown, 173 out of 256 (58.4%) shops belonged to Portuguese. In the villages they had 283 of the 432 (65.5%) shops». Younge states: «Firms such as D'Aguiar's Imperial House, G. Bettencourt & Co, Demerara Pawnbroking & Trading Co, D.M. Fernandes Ltd, The Eclipse, J.P. Santos, Ferreira & Gomes, Guiana Match and Rodrigues & Rodrigues once dominated the waterfront area». The larger number of Madeiran indentured labourers brought to Guyana may explain the relatively large number of trading businesses owned by Madeirans in that country. Ferreira¹⁰ provides the following overview of Madeirans who settled in British-Caribbean countries in a specific period.

This shows that the number of Madeirans in Guyana was far higher than in Suriname. The larger number may also explain other developments in the Madeiran community in Guyana. One of them is the continuation of Madeiran customs until well into the 19th century, highlighted by Menezes¹¹. She makes several assertions, including that a Portuguese Society was founded in 1872 to support widows and orphans, to provide assistance in the case of illness, unemployment or incarceration of fellow Madeirans, and to function as an old age pension scheme. «Prominent among these societies was the Portuguese Society, established in 1872 for the relief of widows,

orphans, and for mutual support of members in sickness, unemployment, old age and imprisonment»¹². Menezes also states that Madeirans in Guyana expressed the need for Portuguese-speaking clergy: «they suffered for want of Portuguese-speaking priests»¹³. These priests were subsequently appointed: «The Superior, [...] had brought with him two Portuguese-speaking priests»¹⁴. A great many Madeirans in Guyana continued to speak Portuguese until the end of the 19th century: «Throughout the nineteenth century the majority of the Portuguese continued to speak the language among themselves»¹⁵. There were also Portuguese schools and newspapers printed in Portuguese. The Madeiran community in Guyana was completely different to that in Suriname in this regard, where neither of the developments relating to language and culture occurred with any clarity. The absence of these trends in Suriname may be related to the small number of Madeirans and the rapid inter-ethnic mixing with Surinamese belonging to other groups. Brand Flu¹⁶ does observe that «a few traditions did continue for a long time (such as Christmas dinner, consisting of *Carne de Vinho e Alhos*).»

Madeiran Names Borne by Surinamese People

A clear legacy of the presence of Madeirans in Suriname is the names of various Surinamese people, which are the same as those of indentured labourers from Madeira and are stated in the first appendix to this article titled «Family Names and Serial Numbers of 218 Madeiran Indentured Labourers in Suriname». My research has revealed that the following names currently occur in Suriname: Abreu, de [de Abreu]; Alexandre; Alfonso [Alfonço]; Auguste [Augusta]; Bruno [Bruno, de]; Caldeira; Castro, de [de Castro]; Coelho; Ferreira; Freitas, de; Gomes; Gonsalves; Jesus, de [de Jezus]; Mendes de Saussa; Mendonca; Nunes; Oliveira, de [Oliveira, 'd]; Rodrigues; Rose; Roza; Da Silva.

In the lecture given by Dos Ramos in 2003¹⁷ he also states names of Surinamese people whose ancestors came from Madeira but were not necessarily imported as indentured labourers. The names are: Dos Ramos; Goncalves; De Faria; De Gama; Gomes; Silvestre; Da Ponte; Correia; De Castro; De Freitas; Nunes; De Sousa; De Jesus; Soares; D'Agrella; Vasconcellos; Miranda.

Dos Ramos subsequently added several names. «Besides these names I have, on closer examination, found several others, these being: Gouvea, Antonio Joao Rodrigues, de Freitas, Nobrega, Mattos, D'Abreu, De Gamma, Esevedo, Mendes, Nunes, Oliveira»¹⁸.

The names of some Surinamese people can refer to their Madeiran heritage. However, this does not apply to their appearance. Some Madeirans mixed with Creoles, a phenomenon observed much earlier by Dos Ramos, as we can see in the following comment: «These days there are very few Surinamese with a Madeiran-Portuguese background that identify as Portuguese, and they are frequently categorised as ethnically Creole or "other".»¹⁹

Conclusion

In a period of just over one year, 1863-1864, 218 Madeiran Portuguese were transported to Suriname to work as indentured labourers. The group consisted of 61 women, 13 of whom were younger than 11 years of age, and 157 men; 14 of the men were under 11 years of age. The mortality rate amongst the indentured labourers was extremely high and even amounted to 39%. However, there was scant resistance amongst the indentured labourers in terms of abscondment.

Our impression is that the descendants of the Madeiran indentured labourers retained almost nothing of their original culture in comparison with the Madeirans living in Guyana. The descendants of some Madeirans mixed with Creoles in particular.
